


### Reading and academic success

- Reading has the highest impact on cognitive development.





## **Access Testing**

- All students complete a reading age test twice per year.
- Students who require further intervention are supported through evidence-led programmes:
  - Fresh Start Phonics
  - Lexia

- Encourage your child to use the library and ask for reading recommendations.
